Subj: MOTORCYCLE REGULATIONS

1. Purpose. To direct pen changes to the basic Order.
2. Pen changes
 - a. Page 2, paragraph 4.b. replace "Marshall" with "Marshal".
 - b. Enclosure 1, pages 1 through 8 replace "MOTORCYCLE" with "MOTORCYCLE".
 - c. Enclosure 1, page 2, paragraph 1-2.e. delete the words "or belt".
 - d. Enclosure 1, page 4, paragraph 2-3 replace "45" with "120".
 - e. Enclosure 1, page 7, paragraph 3-3 replace "on the first Friday of every other month ...)." with "quarterly and semi-annual safety stand-downs. Units are encouraged to host more frequent meetings."
3. Summary of Change. This change clarifies personal protective equipment as outlined by the Headquarters Marine Corps, Safety Division for motorcycles while in uniform or dark colored civilian attire and during the hours of darkness. It corrects administrative errors and changes the frequency of meetings in accordance with the commanding general's recent decision.
4. Filing Instructions. File this change transmittal immediately following the signature page of the basic Order.
