Subj: MOTORCYCLE REGULATION CHANGES

1. Situation. To direct pen changes to the basic Order as a result of a thorough comparison of MCO 5100.19E and the base Order.

2. Mission. This change reflects necessary clarification upon thorough comparison of MCO 5100.19E and the base Order. It clarifies reflective gear requirements, adds prohibiting dark lenses at night and recording of course completion requirements.

3. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations.

(1) Add "Do not wear dark lenses after sundown." to the end of paragraph 1-2.b. of enclosure 1.

(2) Remove paragraph 1-2.e. and replace with "A brightly colored outer upper garment (over 50%) during the day and at night a mesh/fabric vest that is bright yellow, international orange or lime green with two 1½" to 2" wide vertical or horizontal retro-reflective strips front and back at night. The vest is authorized for wear by Marines in uniform, and should be removed as soon as the Marine gets off the motorcycle. The garment must not be covered or concealed, such as by a backpack." to enclosure 1.

(3) Enclosure 1, page 2, add after 1-3.a. " b. Record of course completion. A letter will be forwarded to the individuals command attesting to the date and location of course completion. A unit diary and SRB/OQR entry should be made to include completion date and card number issued to the student.

b. Coordinating Instructions. Comply with contents of this Order.

4. Administration and Logistics. File this change transmittal immediately following the signature page of the basic Order.

5. Command and Signal

a. Signal. This base Order is effective the date signed

b. Command. This base Order is applicable to the Marine Corps Base Hawaii.
