

COMMANDING GENERAL'S POLICY LETTER 3-02

From: Commanding General, Marine Corps Base Hawaii

Subj: NORTH BEACH ACCESS

1. Purpose. To set forth guidance, and procedures to allow access to North Beach for use by all active duty service members, retired service members, and their families.
2. Guidance. Effective 24 May, I intend to allow active duty service members, retired service members, and their families, regardless of service or current duty station, access to North Beach. Since North Beach is located in a residential area, the access for all beach-users must be balanced against neighborhood safety concerns.
3. Procedures
 - a. There will be parking spaces clearly marked for beach parking within the vicinity of the North Beach access. These designated spaces will prevent beach users from blocking driveways and interfering with the residents' parking.
 - b. Appropriate signs at the beach access will be erected to put beach users on notice of the rules for North Beach use and access.
 - c. For those service members, retired service members and their families who do not have MCBH vehicle decals, PMO will issue a limited number of North Beach passes at the Main Gate Pass House. These passes will be displayed in the windshield. This procedure will assure identification of all vehicles parked in the North Beach access area. The North Beach visitor passes will also identify the authorized parking area.
 - d. There will be five parking spots designated for exclusive use by persons displaying the North Beach visitor pass.
 - e. There will be no restrictions on the number of people per car.
